FIRST AID & SECURITY SERVICES

For First Aid and Security Assistance, please visit Security located at the front gate 24/7 during events. They may also be contacted at the Gate 678-693-4253 or Security Office at 678-693-4258. Security staff is in direct contact with on-site medical personnel and emergency service.

Motorsports Emergency First Aid stations are located infield near the Fan Zone (across from the American Flag). If you cannot make it to the infield, please notify a security guard, event staff, State Trooper or Sheriff's Deputy and they will assist you.

RULES OF THE INFIELD

- Firearms or weapons are prohibited
- Emotional support, therapy, comfort or companion animals that provide comfort by being with a person are NOT qualified by the ADA as service animals.
- Fireworks are prohibited
- Scaffolding over 6 feet high is prohibited
- Speed limit across the property is 10 MPH
- Place all trash in trash cans or bags
- Cutting down trees & limbs are prohibited
- State of Georgia and Hall County law prohibits alcohol entering the facility
- Glass containers are prohibited
- Staking on fences or asphalt is prohibited
- No campfires permitted on any ground surface, must be in an above ground fire pit or grill
- Quiet Hours are 11:00 PM – 8:00 AM & strictly enforced
- Always leave room for spectators between campsite and fences
- Georgia Helmet Laws are enforced on all Michelin Raceway Road Atlanta Roads, unless designated within the paddock areas
- Homemade modes of transportation are strictly prohibited
- All unlicensed vehicles must have the proper passes
- Off roading is prohibited within the property
- Any use of hoverboards (single or dual-wheeled) is strictly prohibited
- Use of e-bikes, bikes, ATV, 4-wheelers must require a helmet on
- Drones or unmanned aerial vehicle uses are strictly prohibited

CAMPING POLICIES

- All persons entering the facility need a valid ticket or credential for admission.
- Georgia Helmet Laws are enforced on all Michelin Raceway Road Atlanta Roads, unless designated within the paddock areas.
- Search of vehicles, including car trunks, campers, and RVs, is a condition of entry to the facility. Please be prepared to accommodate the attendant upon arrival.
- State of Georgia and Hall County law prohibits alcohol entering facility.
- Glass containers are prohibited.
- Quiet hours apply for all camping areas from 11:00 PM - 8:00 AM
- Fire lanes must be kept clear. Violators will be towed.
- All generators must be properly ventilated and the exhaust positioned so as not to interfere or cause harm to neighboring campers.
- Camping stickers are non-transferrable. Security has the right to remove anyone with a transferred camping sticker off the property.
- Roping off an area in the Non-Reserved camping for any reason is prohibited.
- Scaffolding over six feet high is prohibited.
- Michelin Raceway Road Atlanta reserves the right to remove any signs that are deemed offensive or represent a conflict of interest.
- Vehicle stickers that have been removed for any reason will not be honored for re-admission. Michelin Raceway Road Atlanta is not responsible for lost or stolen stickers.
- During Motul Petit Le Mans, one (1) vehicle pass and one (1) tow vehicle pass will be issued with each reserved/non-reserved RV pass purchased.
- Camping is not permitted on the Spectator Hill or any other area not identified as a camping area.
- No campfires permitted on any ground surface, fire must be in an above ground fire pit or grill.
- All campers are expected to place trash in receptacles or garbage bags.
- Please remove all items from campsite upon departure (furniture, BBQ grills, trash).

DRONE PROHIBITION

Michelin Raceway Road Atlanta, LLC strictly prohibits the use of unmanned aerial vehicles (“UAV”), also known as drones, for any purpose whatsoever at the Michelin Raceway Road Atlanta facility. A UAV, means any aircraft without a human pilot aboard. Michelin Raceway Road Atlanta personnel may remove anyone using an UAV at the Michelin Raceway Road Atlanta facility and confiscate the UAV until the conclusion of the event.

ALCOHOL POLICY

State of Georgia and Hall County law prohibits alcohol from being brought into our facility. Michelin Raceway Road Atlanta offers a variety of food, alcoholic, and non-alcoholic beverages.

WRISTBAND POLICY

- All sales are FINAL – no refunds and no exchanges.
- Wristbands are NON-TRANSFERABLE and NON-EXCHANGEABLE.
- Wristbands MUST be worn securely on wrist for entry into Michelin Raceway Road Atlanta and cannot be slipped on and off.
- Do NOT remove between days, stretch or tamper with your wristband.
- Subsequent and/or multiple presentations of a counterfeited wristband are VOID and will be seized by security/track staff.
- If your wristband is removed by security/event staff for any reason, it WILL NOT be replaced nor refunded.
- If your wristband has been lost, stolen, or damaged can be replaced for the original purchaser, one time only, visit the Will Call/Registration building before entering Michelin Raceway Road Atlanta. Subject to a \$20 wristband replacement fee.
- THERE ARE ABSOLUTELY NO EXCEPTIONS TO THIS WRISTBAND POLICY.

MOTORIZED VEHICLE POLICY

- Georgia Helmet Laws are enforced on all Michelin Raceway Road Atlanta Roads, unless designated within the paddock areas
- Use of e-bikes, bikes, ATV, 4-wheelers must require a helmet on
- Off roading is prohibited within the property
- Any use of hoverboards (single or dual-wheeled) is strictly prohibited within the property
- All unlicensed vehicles must have the proper passes
- All motorized vehicles used to carry people or property, including without limitation, scooters, golf carts, 4-wheelers, powered carts, Segways and ATVs (collectively “Powered Carts”) in use on the property of Michelin Raceway Road Atlanta must be registered.
- Powered Carts must be driven in a safe, slow, and careful manner, and shall at no time exceed any posted or designated speed limit, at all times while on MRRRA property. The number of passengers allowed on a Powered Cart shall not exceed the seat capacity. Passengers shall remain seated at all times. Drivers will yield to pedestrians. Anyone observed driving in a careless or unsafe manner, including without limitation in violation of any provision of this Powered Cart Policy, will be removed from the property and have their Cart Credential revoked. The undersigned agrees to be responsible for compliance with all laws & government regulations for the use of the Powered Cart.
- Powered Carts must be driven by a licensed driver over the age of eighteen (18) with valid driver’s license unless applicable state or local law requires a higher age limit. The number of passengers may not exceed the manufacturer’s designed and installed seating capacity. All passengers must be seated during operation.
- Alcoholic beverages are not permitted in any Powered Carts. No alcohol is to be consumed by any driver or passenger while the Powered Cart is in use. No driver shall operate any Powered Cart while under the influence of alcohol.
- Only Powered Carts equipped with factory installed (or equivalent) front headlights and rear running lights may be operated after daylight hours.

HOW TO DROP A RENTAL RV AT OUR TRACK?

Non-Reserved Campers:

Come in on Wednesday morning! You, the fan, must ensure the company/individual delivering the RV has your Non-Reserved RV Pass! Please make sure you forward the ticket for them to drop it off. Please have them visit Will Call/ Registration to pick up a delivery pass at the Michelin Raceway Road Atlanta Will Call side to pick up a Delivery Pass! They must know where they are going, please refer to our track map!

WHEN DO I LEAVE?

All Reserved, Non-Reserved RV/Tent camper departures are on Sunday Morning to Mid-Afternoon

ENCLOSED TRAILERS

Enclosed trailers may be brought in as long as it stays within your footprint. Non-reserved tent 18' x 18'. Non-reserved RV within 18' x 55'.

WHERE AND WHEN DO I STAGE TO GET IN?

Non-Reserved RV Campers and Non-RV Tent Campers will stage in the staging lanes near HWY 53. You may stage the Saturday before race week at 00:00 (12:00AM). When you enter from Gate 1 turn left and stage in the lane. Please squeeze in as space is limited. Please also ensure you have tickets ready for a smooth load in on Wednesday Morning.



CANOPY (10X10) POLICIES

- Spectator Hill - Canopies are NOT permitted if they block the direct view of the track from any designated hospitality area.
- Spectator Hill - Canopies are NOT permitted to remain overnight.
- Spectator Hill - Canopies are NOT permitted to be connected to any fencing.
- Turn 9-10a - Canopies are NOT permitted in this area.

If a fan is watching the race, do not install a canopy in front of them.

ADA INFO

Parking:

Accessible parking is identified on the Michelin Raceway Road Atlanta event map (see track map). Parking is on a first-come, first-served basis. Depending on your time of arrival, you may be directed to alternate parking if the parking lot becomes full. ***To Request an ADA Shuttle, please text RASHUTTLE to 627227 and your general location. ***

Parking Passes for Motul Petit Le Mans:

Please visit Will Call/Registration office beyond Gate 1. State and local officials will be monitoring entry/access to accessible parking. Parking is on a first-come, first-served basis. Depending on your time of arrival, you may be directed to alternate parking if the parking lot becomes full.

Possess a handicap plate/hanger:

Fan will not need to purchase a parking pass to enter the facility.

Does not possess a handicap plate/hanger:

Fan does not have a handicap license plate/hanger but are visibly handicapped. The fan will purchase a parking pass (at event rate) and the will call/registration office will place a handicap sticker on the pass.

WHEELCHAIR/ECV

Guests are encouraged to bring their own wheelchair or ECV (electronic convenience vehicle) for personal use while visiting Michelin Raceway Road Atlanta, as the track does not provide or rent.

SERVICE ANIMALS

Michelin Raceway Road Atlanta recognizes the importance of service animals in assisting guests with visual and other impairments. A service animal is defined by the ADA as a dog that has been individually trained to do work or perform tasks for an individual with a disability. Tasks performed by the dog must be directly related to the person's disability. Emotional support, therapy, comfort or companion animals that provide comfort by being with a person are NOT qualified by the ADA as service animals.

- Service animals must be under the control of the handler at all times.
- The service animal must be leashed, harnessed or tethered at all times, unless these would hinder the service the service animal is trained to perform.
- If a service animal behaves in a way that poses a direct threat to the health or safety of others, has a history of such behavior, or is not under the control of the handler, that animal may be excluded.
- Guests are responsible for caring for and supervising the service animal, including toileting (bringing their own pet waste disposal bags), feeding, grooming and veterinary care.

Souvenirs can be purchased inside the Fan Zone with the MRRA & IMSA Merchandise! Programs can be purchased at the yellow tents located around the property!

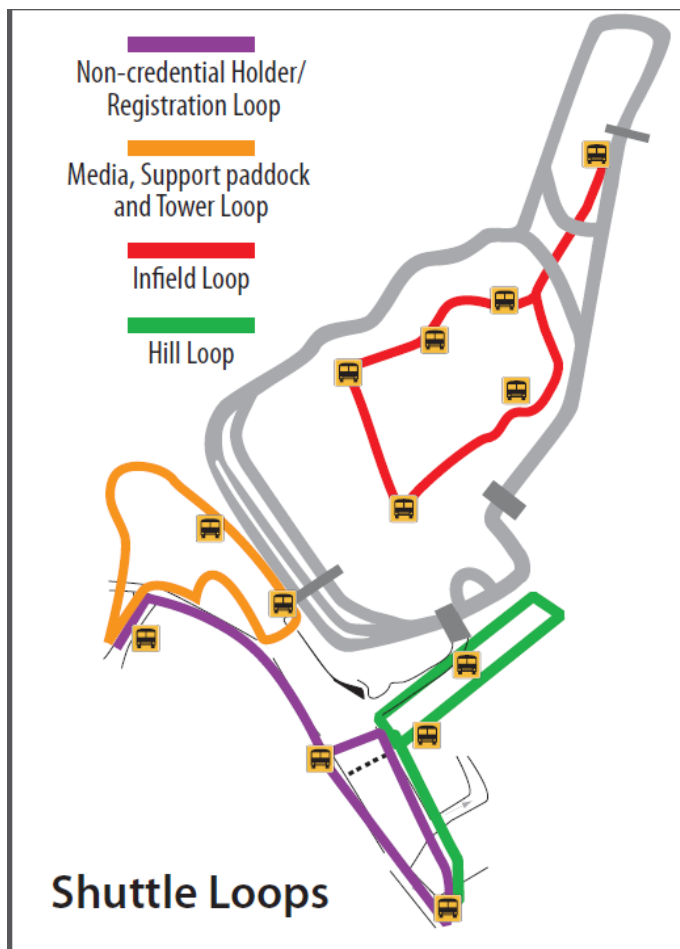
LOST & FOUND

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Where does my ticket allow me to go?

Every ticket for Motul Petit Le Mans allows you to go virtually anywhere except the Hot Pits. Your wristband includes free access to the Paddock and all Spectator-Viewing areas. You must have a special pass to enter certain areas, including the Hospitality tents and the Media Center.

What happens if it rains?

Road racing events like Motul Petit Le Mans go on no matter what the weather does. Rain or Shine!

Where are the best viewing spots?

Popular viewing areas include the Terrace Seating overlooking Turn 10 and Spectator Hill at Turn 5. Both of those locations have jumbotron screens, so you can follow the action on the closed-circuit TV feed for the TV cameras.

How can wheelchairs access the grid walk?

Enter and exit the gate at the Winners Circle.

Where can I purchase Ice?

Ice can be purchased at the Paddock Grill or at the Bar at the top of Spectator Hill.

What time can I load in?

As a non-reserved rv/tent camper, load in is approx. 8 AM on Wednesday!
