The Driving Club is a private car club that offers exclusive access to track time on the infamous 12 turns of Michelin raceway, as well as hospitality access from both the Michelin Tower and the private DCRA clubhouse during most major spectator events and throughout the year. FOX Factory's east coast R&D facility, located just outside the main gates of the property, sits nearly adjacent to the two off-road courses on the western edge of the property that bear the ride dynamics company's name — the FOX Race Face XC Course and the FOX Off-Road Proving Grounds.

or the second year in a row, Motul Petit Le Mans was again affected in 2021 by the ongoing global pandemic, but that didn't stop the 24th running of this iconic event from breaking attendance records and delivering a spectacular show to the fans.

The 24th Annual Motul Petit Le Mans was held in November, a month later than its traditional October date, due to a combination of international sanctioning bodies' scheduling changes and network television commitments. Although this later date meant fans had to wait an extra month to experience race week, the chillier temperatures and additional darkness on race day made for some thrilling on-track action.

The 43-car field of five different classes took the green flag at 12:10pm on Saturday, November 13th, which meant the checkered flag would fall at 10:10pm and gave only about five hours of daylight to the competitors. As the checkered flag fell on an intense final lap, Harry Tincknell, with co-drivers Oliver Jarvis and Jonathan Bomarito, brought the No. 55 Mazda Motorsports Mazda RT24-P to the overall victory in Mazda's final race in the IMSA WeatherTech SportsCar Championship Dayonta Prototype (DPi) class.

The Le Mans Prototype 2 (LMP2) class saw a three-way tussle for the Motul Petit Le Mans victory, with No.

8 Tower Motorsport ORECA LMP2 07 drivers John Farano, Gabriel Aubry and James French gaining the victory when the No. 52 PR1 Mathiasen Motorsports ORECA was penalized postrace for an unserved pitlane drive-through for incident responsibility in a late clash with the No. 8.

The No. 74 Riley Motorsports Ligier JS P320, with pilots Gar Robinson, Felipe Fraga and Scott Andrews, enjoyed a runaway victory in Le Mans Prototype 3 (LMP3) as Robinson cruised to the finish line in the inaugural season of the class.

The outcome of the GT Le Mans (GTLM) class competition wasn't determined until the final 10 minutes of the 10-hour endurance classic. Mathieu Jaminet, in the No. 79 WeatherTech Porsche 911 RSR-19 he shared with Cooper MacNeil and Matt Campbell, edged the team's No. 97 entry by 0.318 seconds at the checkered flag after ceding the lead on the final lap of the IMSA WeatherTech SportsCar Championship season finale.

The GT Daytona (GTD) class provided a full-on exhibition of close racing, constant lead changes and genuine triumph – with Ross Gunn and co-drivers Roman De Angelis and Ian James driving to victory in the No. 23 Heart of Racing Aston Martin Vantage GT3 over the No. 9 Pfaff Motorsports Porsche after 10 hours of intense competition.
