### **SCHEDULE**

The scheduled time for each run group is NOT the time to get to the grid! It is the time your group is leaving the grid. Bring your cars to the Pre-Grid Area 10 minutes BEFORE your session begins. False Grids for both the Tower and the Infield side will be in use for Test Day and Qualifying sessions. All Race Sessions will leave from the Tower False Grid, except HSR NASCAR Classic. If you are paddocked in the Infield Side, you will be lining up at the pit lane gate closest to the walk over bridge. Details of this procedure will be addressed in the Drivers Meeting.

### **STAGING AND LOAD-IN**

Paddock Load-In will begin at 1:00pm on Wednesday, April 23. We will be using both the Infield Paddock and the Tower Paddock. You may begin staging on Tuesday afternoon, April 22. When you arrive prior to load-in time, Track Security will ask for your paddock preference (Tower Paddock or Infield Paddock), and you will be directed to the appropriate staging area based upon your stated preference. Please be respectful of your paddock neighbors. There are some power hook-ups available, these are all on a first-come basis. Power hook-ups in the Paddock are prioritized to working race teams.

### **PADDOCK PARKING**

**Paddock parking passes are limited to two (2) per car entered.** The driver is expected to assign the Paddock Parking passes allotted to his entry by notifying Registration via email in advance of the event. Consider your crew when deciding who is to receive Paddock Parking credentials. We expect both paddocks to be full and carpooling to be necessary. Please make your crew and/or guests aware of this restriction.

### **TEST DAY:**

There will be two (2) Mandatory Test Day Drivers' Meetings. Each Test Day Participant is required to attend one (1) of the two (2) meetings. The Meetings will be on Wednesday, April 23 and Thursday, April 24. See the schedule for specific times. Both meetings will be in the Chalet in the Tower Paddock. You will receive a helmet sticker at these meetings. If you wish to sign up for the Test Day Thursday morning, please see Jack Woehrle at Tech. He will manually add you to the appropriate Test Day group.

### **TRACK ORIENTATION PROGRAM**

HSR offers our Track Orientation Program at this event. Led by multiple championship-winning driver and HSR's Competition Director, Dorsey Schroeder, the Track Orientation Program offers those who are at Road Atlanta for the very first-time valuable insight that otherwise only comes with many miles of track time. The TOP will also provide the returning competitor with a refresher course on this challenging racetrack. The TOP is conducted on Test Day and requires a separate entry to Test Day.

### **TECH:**

Tech Inspection will be set up in the Tower Paddock Tech Building. For those paddocked on the Infield Side, Tech will also be in the building in the middle of the Infield Paddock. Please report to the Tech location in your Paddock. You have all day Thursday to get through Tech. All cars must present their Group Sticker on the Grid beginning Friday morning.

The tech sheet for your entry will be with the tech teams in each Paddock. Your tech inspection must be completed to receive your Group Sticker(s). If you need to present your car for its annual tech inspection, please present your car with the car's logbook to the Tech Inspector. It is your responsibility to see that your car is prepared properly and is safe to race.

### **DRIVERS' MEETINGS:**

All Competitors participating in the Test Day MUST attend one of the two (2) Test Day Drivers' Meetings. One is Wednesday, April 23 and the second is Thursday, April 24. See the schedule for specific meeting times. Both meetings will be held in the Chalet overlooking Pit Lane in the Tower Paddock.

All Competitors must attend one (1) of the two (2) Drivers' Meetings on Friday. See the schedule for the times. These meetings will be held on the second floor of the Tower. Attendance at one of the two meetings is mandatory for all Drivers and Co-Drivers. You will receive your helmet sticker at these meetings. If you miss the meetings, you must see Dorsey Schroeder for review of information provided at the meeting and to receive helmet sticker.

### **SESSION RESULTS:**

### **BLACK FLAG OR RED FLAG:**

A Black or Reg Flag displayed during a session requires all competitors to report to the TOWER Pit Lane. If you report to the INFIELD Pit Lane, you will be released at the back of the field in the event the session is restarted.

### ENDURO PIT LANE DELTA:

There is a time delta between Infield Pit and Tower Pit that was determined by the late Jim Pace on track in a race car.

Competitors that choose to pit on the Infield paddock side are required to perform a 5-minute 7-second pit stop from loop to loop as designated by Signs/Cones. Pit stops must be initiated by the 40-minute mark regardless of location.


### TRANSPONDER RENTALS:

All cars must have an AMB TranX260 compatible transponder (reddish/orange in color). A limited number of rental transponders are available through our Registration Staff. Please have a Transponder Rental Form filled out and ready (form is attached to this packet) and see a member of our Registration Staff. If you need to rent one when you arrive, please let us know and we will get one assigned to you. **All rental transponders must be returned to a HSR staff member at the HSR Trailer or Lyn Hodges Watts prior to your departure from the event.** Please hand transponder to an HSR staff member. You will be charged in full for transponders that are not returned at the end of the event.

### GRIDDING PROCEDURES:

**Practice and Qualifying** – All practice and qualifying sessions will be gridded and released sequentially from both Infield and Tower paddocks. At the discretion of the Chief of Grid, one side of the grid will be released first for the morning sessions and the alternate side will be released first for the afternoon sessions.

**Gridding for Races** – All races will be pre-gridded on the Tower Paddock grid, except for HSR NASCAR Classic. HSR NASCAR Classic will grid on the Infield Paddock side of the track. The pre-grid for HSR NASCAR Classic is on pit lane at pit out.



**Directions to the Grid** – If you are paddocked in the Infield Paddock, you have two (2) choices for gridding for your race. You may drive up and around the perimeter road to the Tower paddock, or you may stage at the paddock gate in the Infield Paddock that is closest to the Tower and Pit-In. Line up next to the fence (driver's right) facing Pit-In (north). You will be directed by a marshal to go counter race from Pit-In, straight across the track and down Tower Paddock Pit-In to Tower Paddock grid.
